Lively on the nose and palate, with hints of peach and apricot, it ages well.

The granite-based terrain and Atlantic winds serve to give structure to the Quinta do Ermizio wines – a family owned business, established for several generations in Minho, the North-Western province of Portugal.

A perfect accompaniment to fish and lighter meats but can also be served as an aperitif.



The Red Wine

D.Graca Reserva perfectly exemplifies the elegance of wines from the Douro region of Portugal.

Characterised by ripe fruit aroma and firm tannins, this wine can be enjoyed now, yet ageing will intensify its bouquet and smooth finish.

The shale and granite terrain of the Douro superior highlands is where the Lourenco family have established their winery, producing quality wines over several generations.
